The Myanmar General Elections successfully completed on 8 November 2015. Following the dramatic win of NLD, this marks a new chapter in Myanmar's future. Berwin Leighton Paisner provides an update of the election results.

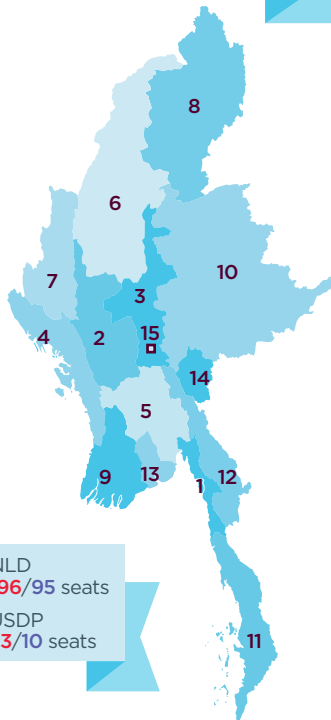

General Elections

- The NLD is well on course to win the number of seats it needs to choose the next President. NLD has previously stated it expected to win 80% of the votes.
- From the seats announced so far (up to 6.30 pm local time on 12 November 2015), the NLD has won: **196 out of 243 seats in the Lower House**
95 out of 116 seats in the Upper House.
- The NLD has also won 382 out of 492 seats (announced so far) in the State and Regional Assemblies.

- Elected representatives of the Lower House, elected representatives of the Upper House and the military appointees each select a presidential candidate.
- Parliament votes for the next President.
