

Myanmar Elections Results

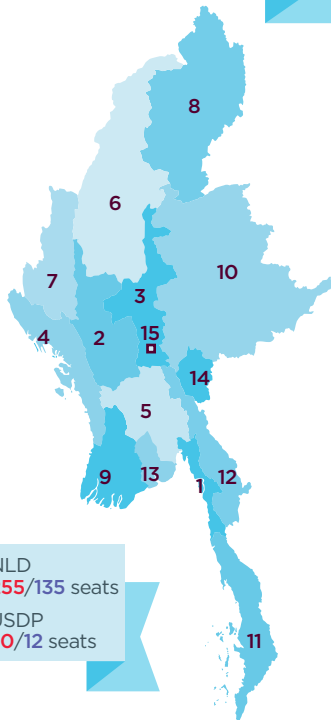
The Myanmar General Elections successfully completed on 8 November 2015. Following the dramatic win of NLD, this marks a new chapter in Myanmar's future. Berwin Leighton Paisner provides an update of the final election results.

November 2015



General Elections

- The NLD has achieved a landslide victory winning approximately 76% of the votes nationwide.
- The NLD has won: **255 out of 330 seats in the Lower House**
135 out of 168 seats in the Upper House.
- The NLD has also won 497 out of 673 seats in the State and Regional Assemblies.
- In addition to elected members, the Myanmar military is guaranteed 25% representation in the Lower House, the Upper House and State and Regional Assemblies.

Next Steps

- The NLD, the current government and the military have agreed to meet in the coming weeks.
- Lower House to convene by 6 February 2016 (i.e. within 90 days from 8 November 2015).
- Elected representatives of the Lower House, elected representatives of the Upper House and the military appointees each select a presidential candidate.
- Parliament votes for the next President.
